Can you answer all these questions each day to test your knowledge?

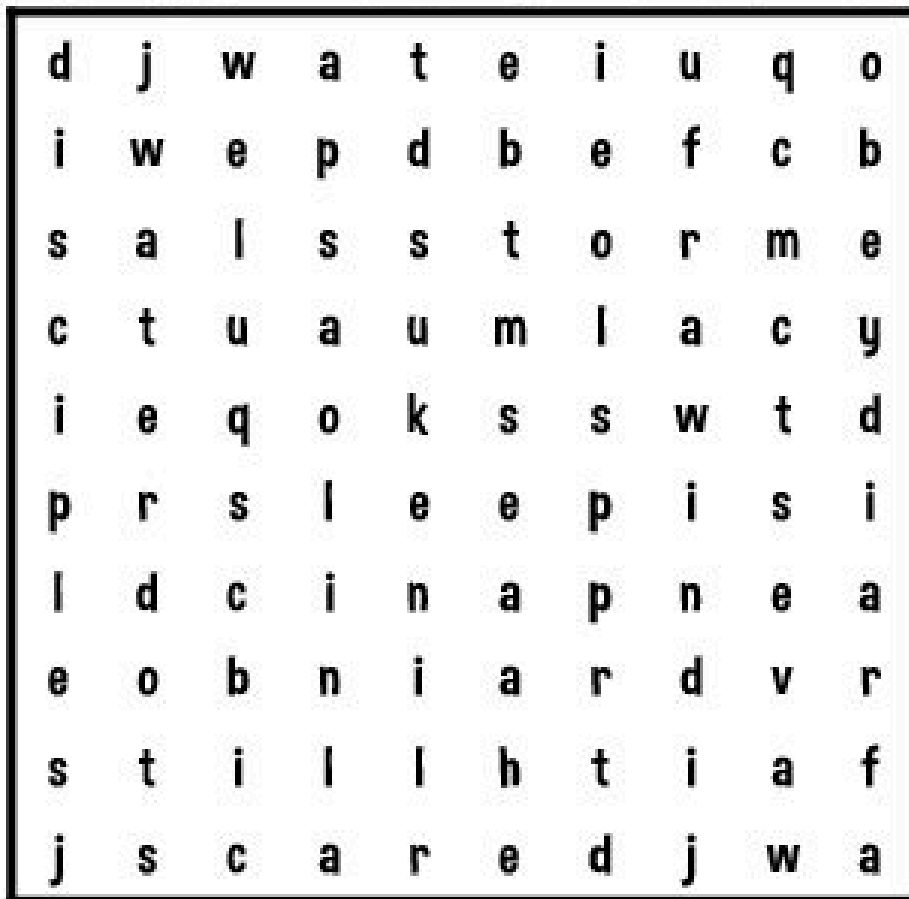

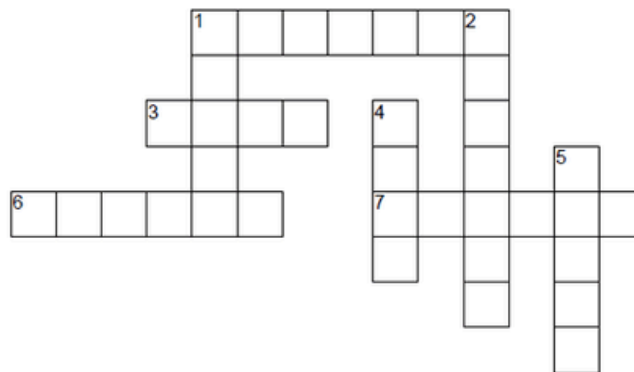
